Inter-Agency Collaboration (IAC)

is an advanced and flexible public safety solution that comprises 3 technology pillars:

Information Governance (IGS)

- Allows information and raw data secure sharing through the authorization and execution of governance policies
- Supports the monitoring of the integrity status of all sensors (fixed, mobile or ad hoc), nodes and servers within the organization
- Data is effectively enforced with role based access control (RBAC) for authorized access to data & information

Benefits:

Supports the Evidence Act that can be presented in courts. Digitally Signed Sensors' content ensures non-repudiation as device/ node integrity is enforced

Safety Awareness Network (SAN)

- Integrates & controls various sensors and content stores, collects & analyses the meta data through numerous/multiple analytics engines with optimized resources utilisation to eliminate performance bottlenecks
- Supports machine-to-machine (M2M) capability that allows its network of sensors to discover new devices deployed within its network without human intervention
- Supports the display of information to the public on a timely basis, based on scenarios such as evacuation route during an emergency

Benefits:

Provides a scalable platform for analytics engines to be plugged in such as Biometrics, Face Recognition, License Plate Recognition, crowd density/counts and others

Geo Spatial Analysis (GSA)

- Receives event and meta data information from multiple sources, and performs aggregation, consolidation, processing and reasoning of these massive collection of data and events
- Presents semantic information to the end-user in an intuitive way to enhance situational awareness perception

Provides right information to the right people at the right place and the right time

IAC is an end-to-end solution that analyzes sensor data and triggers geo-spatial alerts, to enable various stakeholders make sense of a situation in a collective state. IAC offers:


